## Church Finance and Administration

*3 Hour workshop led by Robert Cox*

Participants will understand the importance of proper record keeping. Participants will learn how to record giving, manage cash, and properly report finances to the boards and agencies.

## Grant Writing Workshop

Do you have a wonderful idea for furthering your church's ministry? Do you need more funds than what your individual church can manage? Have you contemplated writing a grant, but not sure how? In this session, participants work through the process of writing a grant. At the end of the session, participants will have the bare bones of a grant and will be able to flesh it out and submit it.

## Pastor Parish Relations Committee Training

*3 Hour workshop offered in two parts*

In Part 1, Rev. George Howle will lead a discussion of the essential work of the PPRC.

In Part 2, Rebecca Neal Tompkins, Certified Payroll Professional, from Forest Acres Payroll, LLC, will help us navigate the ins and outs of church and clergy payroll. Do you know if your church is handling payroll properly? Do you know the difference between clergy payroll and regular employee payroll? Who is considered an employee or an independent contractor? What about those payroll taxes? What documents need to be kept and for how long?
